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## CTPAT Program Minimum Security Criteria (MSC) for NVOCC or Other Intermediary

## Requirements:

- 1. Be an active Air Freight Consolidator, Ocean Transportation Intermediary or Non-Vessel Operating Common Carrier (NVOCC).
- 2. Have an business office staffed in the United States.
- If applicable, have an active Federal Maritime Commission (FMC) issued Organization Number or an International Air Transport Association (IATA) issued Organization Number in the following format: ####### FMC Organization Number and ####### IATA Organization Number
- 4. Possess a valid continuous international carrier bond and/or in bond/export consolidator bond (IBEC) registered with CBP.
- 5. Have a designated company officer that will be the primary cargo security officer responsible for CTPAT.
- 6. Commit to maintaining CTPAT supply chain security guidelines as outlined in the CTPAT consolidator agreement.
- Create and provide CBP with a CTPAT supply chain security profile, which identifies how the consolidator will meet, maintain and enhance internal policy to meet the CTPAT consolidator security guidelines.
